TAX SUPERVISOR - APPOINTMENT

The Manager pointed out that the Constal Statutes of North Carolina require that on the first Monday in July of each odd year the Tax Supervisor must be appointed for a two-year period.

Motion was made by Commissioner Helms, seconded by Commissioner Hawfield, that Tommy J. Haywood be reappointed as Tax Supervisor for Union County. The motion was passed unanimously.

SEWER/SPECIFICATION FOR LABORATORY EQUIPMENT

The specifications for wastewater laboratory equipment were reviewed. After discussion, motion was made by Commissioner Hawfield, seconded by Commissioner Tice, that the Purchasing Officer be authorized to receive sealed bids based on the specifications for laboratory equipment presented. The motion was passed unanimously.

BIDDING POLICY

Chairman Harry Myers suggested the Board adopt a policy which would require specifications on machinery, equipment, etc. to be purchased under formal bidding procedures be brought to the Board prior to advertisements.

After discussion of the recommendation, motion was made by Commissioner Helms, seconded by Commissioner Johnson, that specifications on all purchases to be made through the formal bidding process be brought to the Board of Commissioners prior to advertisement and receipt of bids. The motion was passed unanimously.

TO PROHIBIT SIGNS OF ADVERTISEMENTS AND SOLICITATIONS

The Board discussed in length the problems involved with signs of commercial advertisements and solicitation inside the Courthouse. It was stressed that the Commissioners felt strongly that solicitations should be limited to nonprofit organizations such as children selling for schools or Girl Scout Cookies.

After the discussion, motion was made by Commissioner Hawfield, seconded by Commissioner Johnson that the following policies be adopted to disallow commercial advertisements and solicitations in the Courthouse.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Union County does hereby adopt a policy to prohibit placement of signs of commercial advertisements at any location throughout the Union County Courthouse with the exception of advertisements of events sponsored by nonprofit organizations.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Union County does hereby adopt a policy to prohibit commercial solicitations in the Union County Courthouse.

The motion was passed unanimously.

ROADS

Motion was made by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Commissioner Hawfield, that Castlebrook Drive in Union County be added to the State Road System. The motion was passed unanimously.

JAIL - BUDGET AMENDMENT

Motion was made by Commissioner Hawfield, seconded by Commissioner Johnson, that \$230 be transferred from General Fund Contingency to Jail Operating Expense to appropriate funds needed to complete fiscal year. The motion was passed unanimously.

REASONING FILING FEE REFUND

Commissioner Helms moved, seconded by Commissioner Hawfield, that \$100 be refunded to Faye W. Sherrin for withdrawal of a petition to rezone property filed by Gredy Wilson. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hawfield and was passed unanimously.

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION FOR THE CENTRALINA INTERLOCAL COOPERATIVE CONSORTIUM FOR JOB TRAINING

Motion was made by Commissioner Hawfield, seconded by Commissioner Tice, that the Articles of Association for the Centralina Interlocal Cooperative Consortium for Job Training be approved and the Chairman authorized to execute same. The motion was passed unanimously.

Commissioner Hawfield moved, seconded by Commissioner Helms, that the authorizing resolution for the Centralina Interlocal Cooperative Consortium for Job Training be approved. The motion was passed unanimously.

CENTRALINA JOB TRAINING CONSORTIUM  
RESOLUTION FOR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, the Counties of Cabarrus, Iredell, Lincoln, Rowan, Stanly and Union have requested to be, and have been, designated by the Governor of North Carolina as a Service Delivery Area for purposes of administering and distributing funds and services under the Job Training Partnership Act of 1982, PL 97-300 (hereafter called the JTFA); and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that the County governments in this Service Delivery Area form a consortium or joint undertaking for the purpose of effecting the provisions of JTFA within the said Service Delivery Area; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of this Board of County Commissioners executed on behalf of this county, subject to notification by this Board, the "Centralina Interlocal Cooperative Agreement for Job Training", dated June 28, 1983, which agreement establishes a joint undertaking or consortium pursuant to W.C.G.S 169A-460, et seq. and the JTFA among the counties within the Service Delivery Area, whereby said counties agree to jointly participate in the administration of the JTFA within the Service Delivery Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the participation by this county as a party in the Centralina Interlocal Cooperative Agreement for Job Training, dated June 28, 1983, be and it is hereby ratified in all respects; and that the execution of the foregoing agreement by our Chairman is ratified, confirmed, and adopted by this Board.
