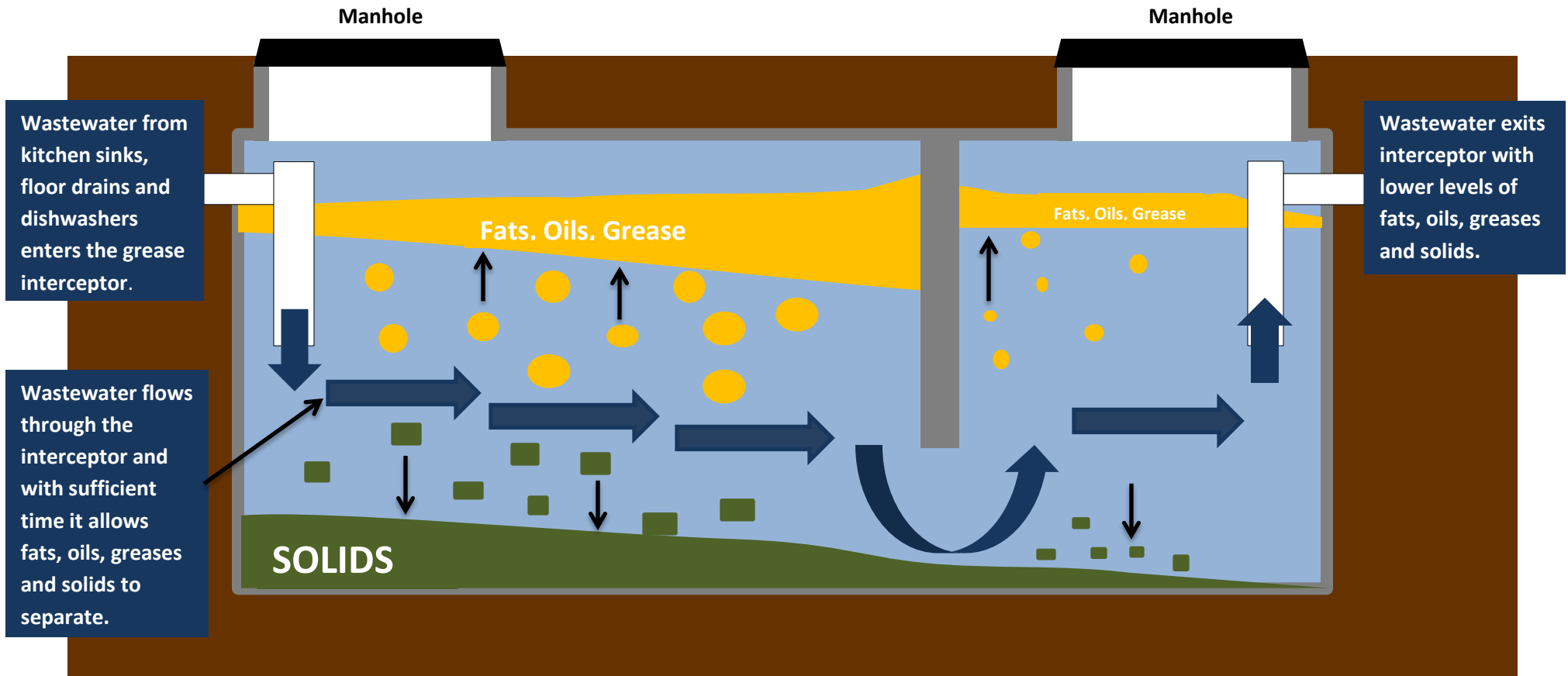




How does a grease trap/interceptor work?

A grease trap/interceptor's purpose is to help reduce fats, oils, greases and solids from entering the sanitary sewer collection and treatment system.



Grease Interceptor Steps

1. Kitchen wastewater enters interceptor.
2. Wastewater is slowed down due to a baffle.
3. Grease floats to the top.
4. Solids sink to the bottom.
5. Wastewater makes its way under baffle.
6. Any grease that still made its way under baffle floats to the top and solids to the bottom.
7. Wastewater (gray water) exits.
