
How does a grease trap/interceptor work?

A grease trap/interceptor's purpose is to help reduce fats, oils, greases and solids from entering the sanitary sewer collection and treatment system.





Grease Interceptor Steps

- 1. Kitchen wastewater enters interceptor.
- 2. Wastewater is slowed down due to a baffle.
- 3. Grease floats to the top.
- 4. Solids sink to the bottom.

- 5. Wastewater makes its way under baffle.
- 6. Any grease that still made its way under baffle

floats to the top and solids to the bottom.

7. Wastewater (gray water) exits.
