All licenses issued in NC are for ceremonies performed ONLY in NC and are issued no more than 60 days before the ceremony.

- 1. Complete the "Application for Marriage License".
- 2. License fee is \$60. We accept cash, money orders or credit card payments. The fee is non-refundable. (Additional fee if paying by credit card)
- 3. Licenses are issued Monday thru Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- 4. Our office is located in the Union County Government Center, 500 North Main Street, 2nd Floor, Suite 258 Vital Records Department.
- 5. If married by ordained minister, must have name, address and phone number.
- 6. You <u>must</u> provide an interpreter if you have any difficulty in speaking and/or reading English. The interpreter must be over 18 years of age and not related to parties receiving the license.
- 7. Must know divorce or death date (month and year).
- 8. <u>16 to 17 year olds</u> (cannot marry someone more than 4 years older) must have the following:
 - a. Valid current State issued ID (name must match social security card or W2)
 - b. Certified birth certificate (with raised seal)
 - c. Must be accompanied by parents (if parents are divorced, only parent w/legal custody necessary. (Must provide certified proof of custody)
 - d. Parents must have valid current State issued ID or drivers license from DMV, military ID or passport.
 - e. Applicants must provide social security cards or current year tax return, or W2. (*name must match ID*)
 - f. <u>If divorced or widowed in the year prior to marriage application, you must supply certified divorce or death certificate.</u>
- 9. 18 years and older must have the following:
 - a. Valid current State issued ID or drivers license from DMV, military ID or passport. (*name must match social security card or W2*)
 - b. Applicants must provide social security cards or current year tax return, or W2. (*name must match ID*)
 - c. <u>If you were not born in the United States, you must have certified birth</u> certificate (with raised seal). (with parent's name on birth certificate)
 - d. <u>If divorced or widowed in the year prior to marriage application, you must supply certified divorce or death certificate.</u>
- 10. You are encouraged to obtain your license a few days before your wedding, in the event there may be a problem with your documents.
- If you plan to get married at the Magistrate's office, you must make an appointment before obtaining a marriage license.
