



## Economic Development

## Program Detail

#### **Program Mission**

The purpose of the Economic Development Program is to enhance the tax base and employment in the County by addressing economic development activities including the recruitment of new and retention of existing manufacturing, distribution and commercial office development.

#### **Program Services Provided**

The Board of County Commissioners adopted an Economic Development Incentive Grant Program to provide financial assistance as an incentive for expanding business investments in Union County. \$1,423,046 is in the FY 2018 budget for existing incentive grant agreements. Related NC Department of Commerce Economic Development Grant(s) in the amount of \$655,000 are also included in the FY 2018 budget.

In 2016, the Board of County Commissioners adopted a Community Development Block Grant Entitlement (CDBG) Program as supervised by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The County has entered into agreements with several municipalities within the County for projects that address Community renewal and lower income housing assistance activities, specifically urban renewal and publicly assisted housing. During FY 2017, this program was relocated to the General Special Revenue Fund, a multi-year special revenue project fund.

In 2013, the City of Monroe and Union County established Monroe-Union County Economic Development as a joint county-wide economic development program. The program encompasses economic development activities throughout the county including recruitment of new and retention of existing manufacturing, distribution and commercial office development. These activities will increase the tax base and employment in the city and county. \$408,000 is in the FY 2018 budget for the County's support to the City of Monroe for the joint county-wide program.
