ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of the STEG Gravity Sewer Improvements - Stallings will be received by Union County Procurement Department, Union County Government Center at 500 N. Main Street, Suite 709, Monroe, North Carolina 28112, until 10:00 AM local time on September 23, 2021, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. The public bid opening will be conducted outdoors, in the front entrance area of the Union County Government Center at the specified bid date and time. Late bids will not be accepted. If you plan to attend the bid opening, social distancing rules apply.

On <u>September 23, 2021</u>, beginning at <u>9:30 AM</u> local time, bids will be received by the Union County Procurement Department at the bid opening location, outdoors in the front entrance area of the Union County Government Center at 500 North Main Street, Monroe, NC 28112.

The Project consists of constructing approximately 4,745 linear feet of 8-inch gravity sewer mains and 24 manholes on Smith Circle, Greenbriar Drive, and Spruce Street. This includes, but is not limited to pipe, manholes, services, clean outs, erosion control, and restoration.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis.

Following registration, complete sets of Bidding Documents may be downloaded as "zipped" portable document format (PDF) files. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of the Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office.

Bidders must have a license to do work as a general contractor in the State of North Carolina, as set forth under Article 1 of Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes. The Contractor's North Carolina License number shall be designated on the outside of the envelope containing the bid.

Bidders are required to comply with the non-collusion requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Union County reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
