Sealed Bids for the construction of the **FY20 SHORT WATER LINE EXTENSIONS – Phase 3** will be received by the Union County Procurement Department, Union County Government Center\*, at 500 N. Main Street, Suite 709, Monroe, North Carolina 28112, until **2:00 PM** local time on **March 23, 2021**, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. This public bid opening will be conducted outdoors, Infront the entrance area of the Union County Government Center address listed above. *If you plan to attend the bid opening, social distancing rules apply.*

\*On **March 23, 2021**, beginning at **1:30 PM** local time, bids will be received by the Union County Procurement Department at the bid opening location, outdoors in the front entrance area of the Union County Government Center at 500 North Main Street, Monroe, NC 28112.

The Project consists of **constructing approximately 365 linear feet of 2-inch water mains, 2,000 linear feet of 6-inch water mains, 12,705 linear feet of 8-in water mains, and related appurtenances on Long Hope Rd, Old Pageland Marshville Rd, Lee Cooke Rd, Landsford Rd, and JJ Autry Rd.**

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis.

Following registration, complete sets of Bidding Documents may be downloaded as “zipped” portable document format (PDF) files. Printed hardcopies of the Bidding Documents can be ordered and shipped for an additional fee, which will depend on the number of sets, size of the Drawings, applicable taxes, and shipping method selected by the prospective Bidder. Costs of Bidding Documents and shipping are non-refundable, and are approximately as follows:

Upon Issuing Office’s receipt of payment, printed Bidding Documents will be sent via the prospective Bidder’s delivery method of choice; the shipping charge will depend on the shipping method chosen. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder’s date of receipt of the Bidding Documents.

Bidders must have a license to do work as a general contractor in the State of North Carolina, as set forth under Article 1 of Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes. The Contractor’s North Carolina License number shall be designated on the outside of the envelope containing the bid.

Bidders are required to comply with the non-collusion requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Union County reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
