



Fees & Policies

This brochure contains useful information for Union County residents who need to dispose of household waste and recyclable materials. These services and any applicable fees are for Union County residents. Commercial customers should inquire with Solid Waste staff or visit the county website for information and fees.

Union County Solid Waste collects fees for most items accepted for waste disposal. Ask about our Trash Pass program for county residents.

A recycling fee is assessed per television. All other recyclable items are accepted for free.

Residential customers may pay via cash or check.

Fees are subject to change. See the site attendant or the county website for the current fee schedule.

Accepted Items

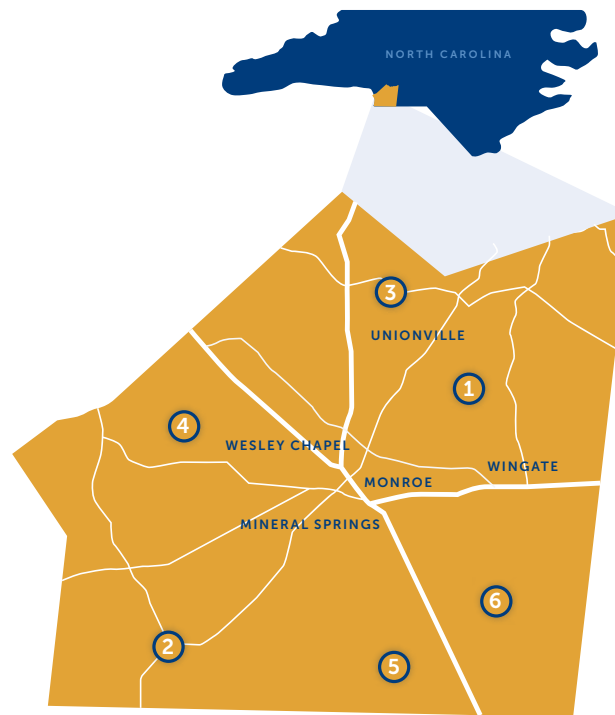
Unless otherwise noted, these items are accepted at all sites:

- used motor oil (5 gallon limit) and oil filters
- electronics*:
 - computers & related equipment (desktops, laptops, tablets, mouse, keyboards, printers, ink and toner cartridges, power supplies, cables, Central Processing Units, main processors, & electronic circuit boards)
 - mobile phones
 - CRT or flat panel televisions & monitors
 - miscellaneous electronics (copiers, CD & DVD players, VHS recorders, cameras, satellite equipment routers, modems, speakers, video game equipment, telephone equipment, fax machines, and scanners)
 - small appliances (toasters, toaster ovens, vacuum cleaners, microwaves, blenders, mixers, fans, and heaters)

The Union County Solid Waste Facility and Landfill also accepts these items for disposal:

- mattresses, furniture, and other bulky items
- construction and demolition waste
- yard waste
- white goods (refrigerators, washers, dryers, etc.)
- tires (off the rim) – limit 5
- scrap metal
- auto coolants
- lead acid batteries

Accepted Items for Recycling	Examples or Special Instructions
Cardboard	Break down boxes into flat sheets of cardboard.
Steel Cans	Rinse all cans before recycling. Ex. canned vegetables, fruit, or soup
Aluminum Cans	Rinse all cans before recycling. Ex. soda/soft drink cans, beer cans
Paper Cartons	Ex. beverage cartons, juice boxes
Mixed Paper	Ex. junk mail, newspaper, magazines
Glass Bottles & Jars	No plate glass or ceramics.
Plastics	Bottles and jugs designated #1 and #2 only.
