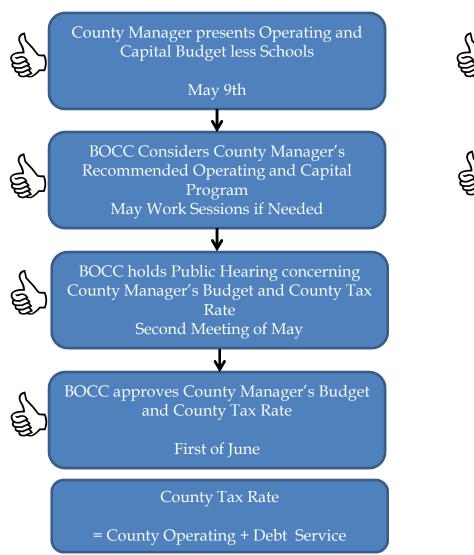


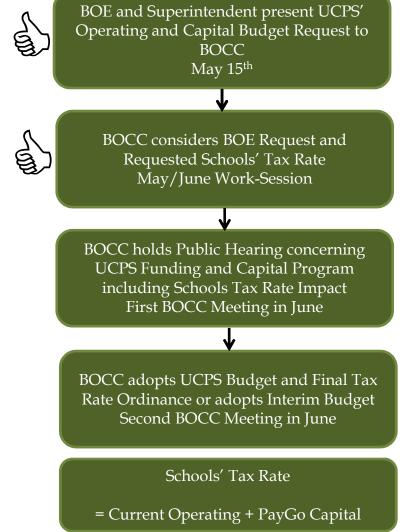

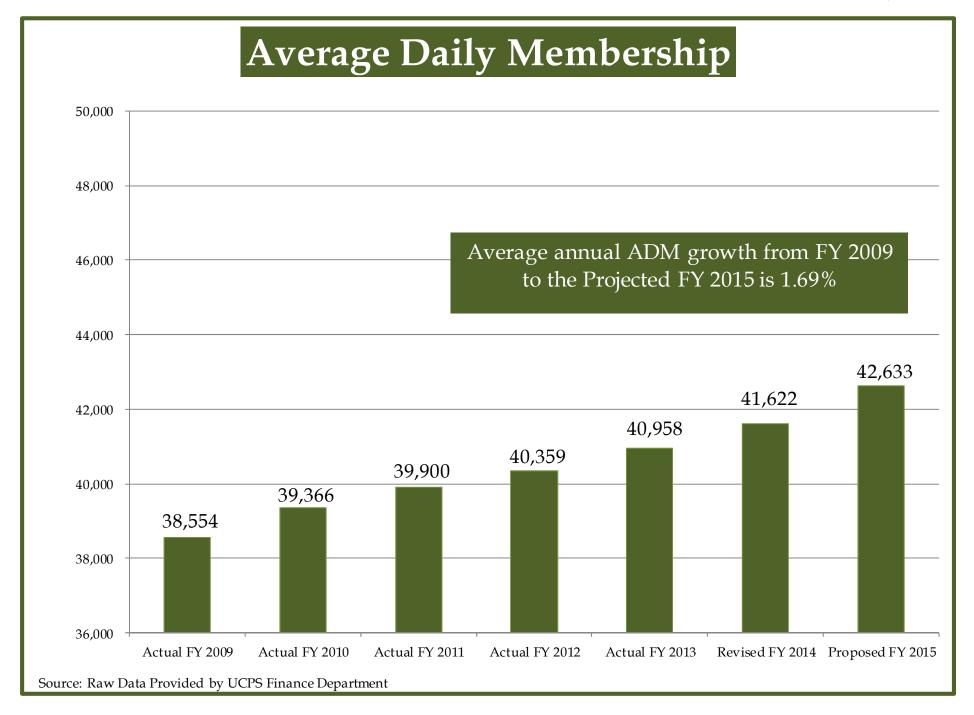
- Public Hearing Concerning the Proposed FY 2015

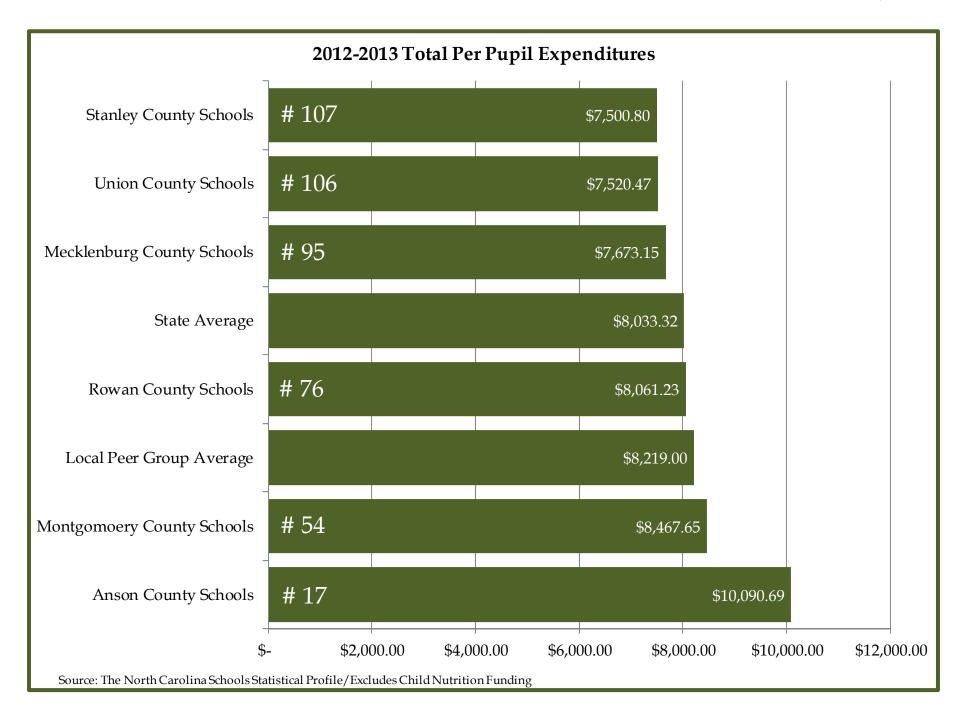

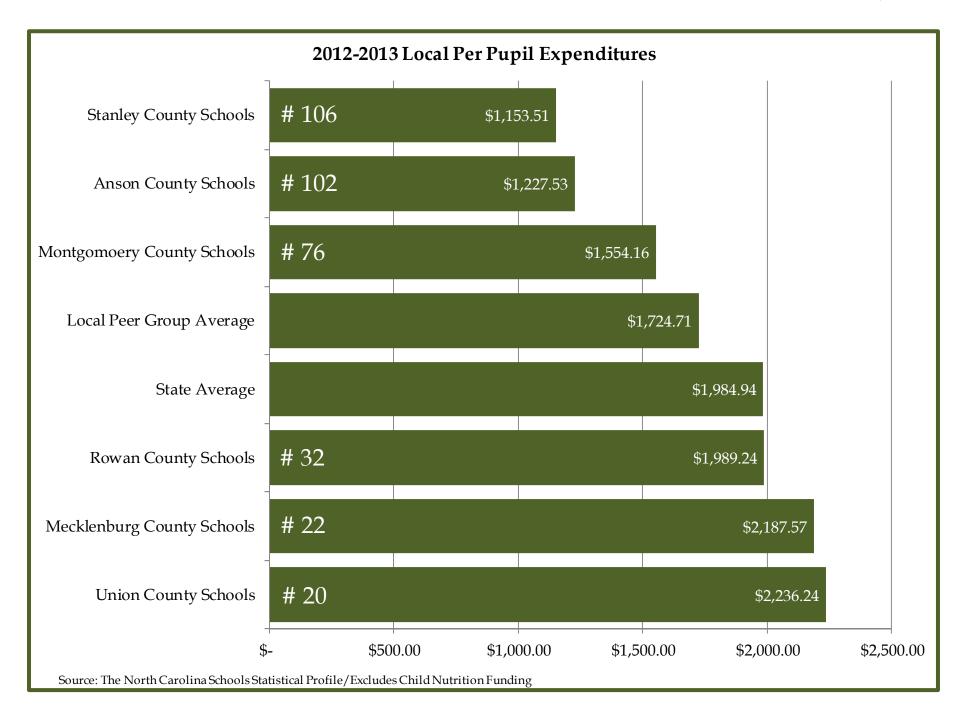

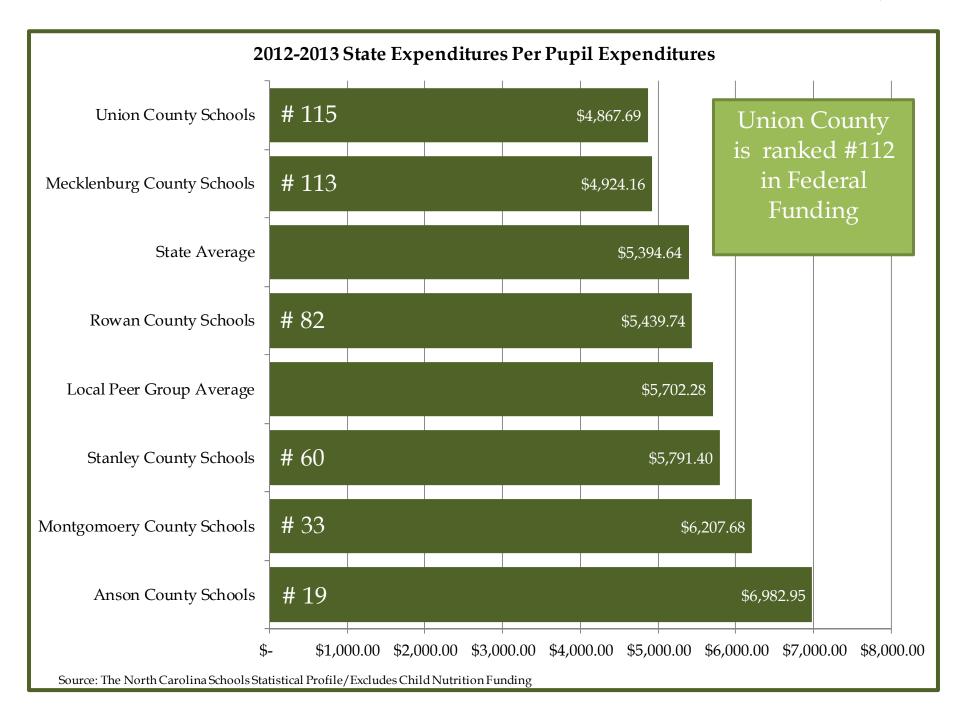
