

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Twelve Mile Creek WRF – Building Additions will be received by the Union County Procurement Department until *2:00 PM local time on January 13, 2022 at the Union County Government Center, 500 N. Main Street, Suite 709, Monroe North Carolina, 28112. The public bid opening will be conducted in the Union County Board Room the specified bid date and time. Late bids will not be accepted.

On January 13, 2022, beginning at *1:30 PM local time, bids will be received by the Union County Procurement Department at the bid opening location. <u>If you plan to attend the bid opening, masks and social distancing rules may apply.</u>

A Pre-Bid Conference was held on-site at 8299 Kensington Drive, Waxhaw, NC 28173 on November 30, 2021 at 2:00 PM local time. Attendance was encouraged but not required.

Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Bidders must have a license to do work as a general contractor in the State of North Carolina, as set forth under Article 1 of Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes. The Contractor's North Carolina License number shall be designated on the outside of the envelope containing the bid.

Bidders are required to comply with the non-collusion requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

Bidders should note the provisions of the Instructions to Bidders contained in the Bid Documents regarding minority participation. Union County encourages good faith effort outreach as described in the Union County MBE and Small business Outreach Plan. Compliance with Union County Minority and Small Business Guidelines and Outreach Plan goals apply. Bidders shall <u>submit a completed identification of Minority Participation form and either an Affidavit A or Affidavit B, as applicable along with their Bid.</u>

Union County reserves the right to reject any or all bids including without limitation, nonconforming, nonresponsive, unbalanced, or conditional Bids. Owner further reserves the right to reject the Bid and Bidder whom they find, after reasonable inquiry and evaluation, to not be responsible. Owner may also reject the Bid and Bidder if the owner believes that would not be in the best interest of the Project to make an award to that Bidder. Owner also reserves the right to waive all informalities and technicalities not involving price, time, or changes in the Work and to negotiate, as allowed by law, contract terms with the Successful Bidder.
