3. **Add** to Section 1 Notice of Advertisement and Section 4 Project Background the following:

This project has received approval from the North Carolina Division of Environmental Quality Division of Water Infrastructure (NCDEQ, DWI) to utilize American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. Compliance with all reporting and documentation requirements in place at the time services are rendered will be required for this project.

This solicitation follows the Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal awards (2 C.F.R. Part 200). Contracts resulting from this solicitation may be funded with federal grant funds which have been procured in a manner that is in compliant with all applicable Federal laws, policies, and standards as well as state law and local policies.

The County intends to pay, in part or in whole, the cost of the contract resulting from this solicitation, using monies received from the Fiscal Recovery Funds (including, without limitation, the Interim Final Rule (86 Fed. Reg. 26,786 (May 17, 2021) and Final Rule (87 Fed. Reg. 4,338 (Jan. 27, 2022))), the Award Terms and Conditions applicable to the Fiscal Recovery Funds, and such other guidance as Treasury has issued or may issue governing the expenditure of monies distributed from the Fiscal Recovery Funds (collectively, the "Regulatory Requirements").
