

## Teen Discord Server Guidelines

### **Be Respectful of Everyone**

Remember to be kind and respectful! Everyone comes from a different background! No trolling, spamming, bullying, or hate speech of any sort will be tolerated. The Union County Library has zero bullying tolerance. Bullying is defined as: "unwanted, aggressive behavior that involves a real or perceived power imbalance." (Definition source: [stopbullying.gov](http://stopbullying.gov)) Verbal bullying includes teasing, name-calling or taunting. Social bullying includes leaving someone out.

### **Channel Topics**

Have fun! Please do not spam the chat or other server members in their DMs. Remember to respect the topics of each channel. Do not share links containing viruses/malware. Do not ping users. The @everyone feature is reserved for the Teen Advisory Group (TAG) and Librarians only.

### **Keep Content PG-13**

The Union County Library Teen Server is rated PG-13! Do not post any graphic content, including explicit language, sexual content, violence, or gore. If you have questions about if you should post something, reach out to @Librarians.

### **Boundaries & More**

Do not send unwanted friend requests or messages (especially if a user has made it clear that they do not want to talk to you anymore). Do not share private, personal information about yourself or others.

The Library reserves the right to delete any comments or remove users at any time who cannot follow the above guidelines.
