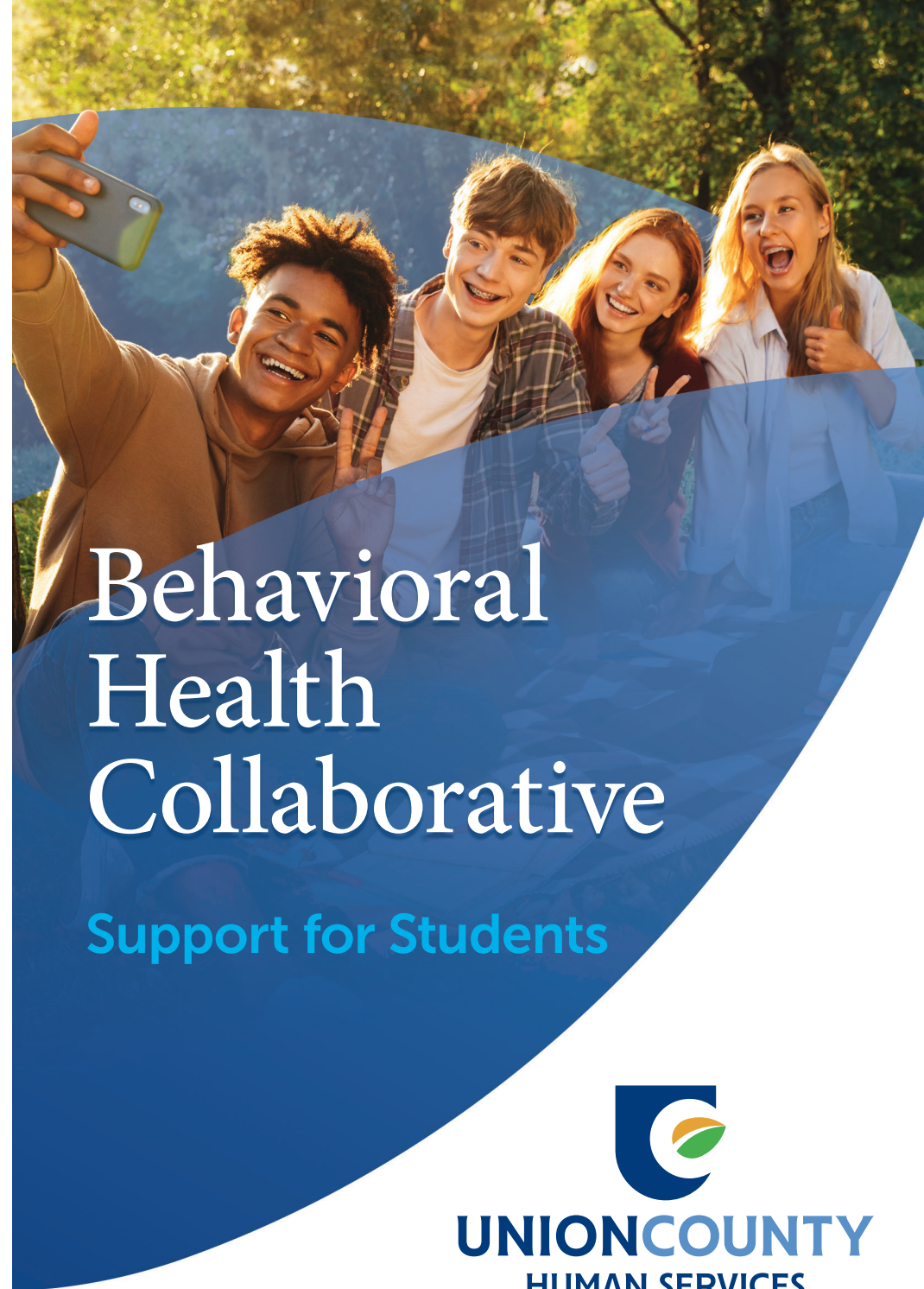

The Behavioral Health Collaborative is a partnership between Union County Social Services and Union County Public Schools to support the social, emotional and mental health well-being of students across Union County.

The team consists of School Social Workers and Behavioral Health Therapists who serve the following school clusters:

Our Services

SCHOOL SOCIAL WORKERS



- Support students with concerns impacting them at school and or home.
- Help students with developing social, coping and decision-making skills.
- Connect students and families with community resources like utilities, food and clothing assistance.
- Assist students with transitioning to or in Union County Public Schools.

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH THERAPISTS



- Complete intake and assessment to inform understanding student's needs.
- Triage request for service to connect students with the appropriate level of support.
- Provide short-term, school-based therapy as appropriate and connect students to a higher level of care when more is needed.
