Popcorn Recipe

- In a pot, fill the bottom with 3-4 tablespoons of oil on high heat.
- Put 1 kernel, in pot and cover with lid. Wait till it pops.
- Pour 1 cup of kernels into the pot and cover with lid.
- Once the popping has stopped, remove from stove and put popcorn in a big bowl.
- In the same pot, put 1-2 tablespoons of butter. Once the butter has melted pour over popcorn.
- Add your favorite seasonings.
