## Candidate Filing for 2024 Elections Begins December 4

Candidate filing for the 2024 elections begins at noon on **Monday**, **December 4**, **2023**, and ends at noon on **Friday**, **December 15**, **2023**.

Depending on the office sought, candidates will file their Notice of Candidacy and pay their filing fee either at the Union County Board of Elections, 316-B East Windsor Street, Monroe, NC 28112 or with the State Board of Elections at the N.C. State Fairgrounds in Raleigh. Filing fees must be paid by cashier check, campaign check, personal check, or money order.

The 2024 primary election is **March 5**. The general election is **November 5**.

Soil and Water Conservation District Supervisor is a non-partisan contest, so those candidates will file at the Union County Board of Elections office beginning at noon on June 10, 2024 and ending at noon on July 5, 2024.
