

**NOTICE OF SECOND PRIMARY ELECTION  
UNION COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA**

The statewide second primary will be held on Tuesday, May 14, 2024.

Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Election Day. Voters must go to their assigned precinct on Election Day.

**Voters will be asked to show photo ID when they vote.** All voters will be allowed to vote with or without ID. Voters who lack ID can get one for free from their county board of elections. Find out more at [BringItNC.com](http://BringItNC.com).

Early voting will be held at the Union County Public Library, Griffin Room, 316 East Windsor St., Monroe NC 28112 from Thursday, April 25, 2024, to Saturday, May 11, 2024. The site will be open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. and Saturday, May 11, from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

Absentee ballots will be mailed to voters who have requested them as soon as they are available. A voter can fill out an absentee ballot request at [votebymail.ncsbe.gov](http://votebymail.ncsbe.gov), or by filling out a request form provided by the board of elections. The request must be received through the website or by the Union County Board of Elections by 5 p.m. May 7, 2024.

All voters who are registered with the political party of the candidates on the ballot are eligible to vote in the second primary. Additionally, voters who are not affiliated with any party and who either didn't vote in the first primary or voted the ballot of the party for which the second primary is being held are eligible to participate. For example, if a second primary is held for the Republican nomination for lieutenant governor, then all registered Republicans and unaffiliated voters who did not vote or voted the Republican ballot in the first primary would be eligible.




**RESOLUTION OF THE UNION COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS  
ACTION ON APPLICATIONS FOR ABSENTEE BALLOTS  
MAY 14, 2024 SECOND PRIMARY ELECTION**

**WHEREAS**, General Statute 163-230.1(f) states that county board of elections shall hold public meetings commencing on the fifth Tuesday before an election at 5:00 p.m. for the purpose of action on applications for absentee ballots. If the county board of elections changes the time of holding its meetings or provides for additional meetings, notice of the change in hour and notice of the schedule of additional meetings, if any, shall be published in a newspaper circulated in the county at least 30 days prior to the election.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Union County Board of Elections adopts a resolution to allow the time of the required meetings on April 9, April 16, April 23, April 30, and May 7, 2024 to begin at 2:00 p.m. in their office located at 316-B East Windsor St., Monroe NC and to schedule additional meetings for Monday, May 13, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. and Friday, May 24, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. for action on applications for absentee ballots.


**RESOLUTION OF THE UNION COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS  
COUNTING ABSENTEE BALLOTS  
MAY 14, 2024 SECOND PRIMARY ELECTION**

**WHEREAS**, NC General Statute 163-234(2) states that a county board of elections shall meet at 5:00 p.m. on election day in the board office for the purpose of counting all absentee ballots except those which have been challenged before 5:00 p.m. on election day and those received pursuant to G.S. 163-231(b)(2)b. or c. The board shall not announce the result of the count before 7:30 p.m.

**WHEREAS**, upon the adoption of a resolution at least two weeks prior to the election in which the hour and place of counting absentee ballots shall be stated, the board may provide for an additional meeting following the day of the election and prior to the day of canvass to count absentee ballots received pursuant to G.S. 163-231(b)(2)b. or c. A copy of the resolution shall be published once a week for two weeks prior to the election, in a newspaper having general circulation in the county.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Union County Board of Elections shall meet at the Board of Elections office, 316-B East Windsor St., Monroe NC at 5:00 p.m. on election day, May 14, 2024, for the counting of absentee ballots. The board will also meet on Friday, May 24, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. to review and count provisional ballots and supplemental absentee ballots.
