

## **PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** the Union County Board of Commissioners (the “Board”) will hold a public hearing on Monday, May 20, 2024, beginning at 6:00 p.m. in the Commissioners’ Board Room, First Floor, Union County Government Center, 500 North Main Street, Monroe, NC, in accordance with Part 1 of Article 16 of Chapter 153A of the North Carolina General Statutes and other relevant authority, for the purpose of receiving public comment concerning the following:

1. Proposed extension of the Wesley Chapel Fire and Rescue Service District for the provision of fire protection and rescue services pursuant to the County Service District Act of 1973, effective July 1, 2024;
2. Abolition of the Providence Fire and Rescue Service District effective July 1, 2024; and
3. The proposed extension of the Wesley Chapel Response District to be coterminous with the proposed extended Wesley Chapel Fire and Rescue Service District, and abolition of the Providence Response District, effective July 1, 2024.

A report containing certain information concerning the extension of the Wesley Chapel Fire and Rescue Service District, as required by N.C.G.S. § 153A-303(d), is available for inspection in the office of the Clerk to the Board, located at 500 North Main Street, Suite 932, Union County Government Center, Monroe, NC, during regular business hours. This report includes a map of the existing service district and adjacent territory, showing the present and proposed boundaries of the district.
