Sealed bids for Jesse Helms Park Playground Equipment will be received by the Union County Procurement Department *until* **2:00 PM** local time on **May 30, 2024** at the Union County Government Center, 500 North Main Street, <u>Suite 709</u>, Monroe, NC 28112 at which time the bids will be opened and read aloud. **Late bids will not be accepted**.

Part 200). Contracts resulting

from this solicitation may be funded with federal grant funds which have been procured in a manner that is in compliance with all applicable Federal laws, policies, and standards as well as state law and local policies.

2 BID SUBMISSION

2.1 BID SUBMISSION DEADLINE

Sealed bids are to be received by the Union County Procurement Department for Jesse Helms Park Playground Equipment until <u>May 30, 2024 at 2:00 PM Local Time</u> at the Union County Government Center, 500 North Main Street, Suite 709, Monroe, NC 28112 at which time the bids will be opened and read aloud. Late bids will not be accepted.

2.2 BID DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS

Union County, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to supplement, amend, substitute or otherwise modify this IFB at any time, to cancel this IFB with or without the substitution of another IFB, and to issue additional request for information.

2.4 BID QUESTIONS

Bid questions will be due on or before <u>May 15, 2024 at 5:00 PM</u> local time. The primary purpose of this is to provide participating Bidders with the opportunity to ask questions, in writing, related to the IFB.

2.5 BID ADDENDUM

Union County may modify the IFB prior to the date fixed for submission of Bids by the issuance of an addendum. Should an Offeror find discrepancies or omissions in this IFB, or any other documents provided by Union County, the Offeror should immediately notify the County of such potential discrepancy in writing via email as noted above.

Any addenda to these documents shall be issued in writing. No oral statements, explanations, or commitments by anyone shall be of effect unless incorporated in the written addenda. Receipt of Addenda shall be acknowledged by the Offeror on <u>Appendix</u> D – Addendum and Anti-Collusion Form.

3 INTRODUCTION

3.1 COUNTY

Union County, North Carolina (population 254,070) is located in the central, southern piedmont. The County provides its citizens with a full array of services that include public safety, water/wastewater utilities and sanitation, human services, cultural and recreational activities, and general government administration.

3.2 PURPOSE

Union County, North Carolina, through Parks and Recreation, is soliciting bids from qualified firms to furnish, deliver and install playground equipment to Jesse Helms Park as outlined in this solicitation.

3.3 NOTICE OF FEDERAL FUNDING

Union County has received a payment from the Community Development Block Grant established pursuant to 24 C.F.R. 570.208 (a)(3), Union County may utilize such the Community Development Block Grant, in whole or in part, for the cost of the Agreement resulting from this solicitation and the services provided thereunder. In using these funds, the County must comply with the terms of Community Development Block Grant, regulations issued by U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development governing the expenditure of monies distributed from the Community Development Block Grant, the Award Terms and Conditions applicable to the Community Development Block Grant and such other guidance as the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has

issued or may issue governing the expenditure of monies distributed from the Community Development Block Grant (collectively, the "Regulatory Requirements").

The County must comply with the Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards, 2 C.F.R. Part 200, other than such provisions as the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has determined or may determine are inapplicable to the Community Development Block Grant.

Pursuant to 2 C.F.R. § 200.327, the County must include within the Agreement applicable provisions described in Appendix II to 2 C.F.R. Part 200 and all other applicable law. Therefore, the County cannot enter into an Agreement or make any distributions to Offeror using monies from the Community Development Block Grant absent agreement and adherence to each term and condition contained therein.

4 INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 COMMUNICATION

All communications, any modifications, clarifications, amendments, questions, responses or any other matters related to the IFB must be made only through the Procurement Contact noted on the cover of this solicitation. A violation of this provision is cause for the County to reject a Company's bid. No contact regarding this document with other County employees is permitted and may be grounds for disqualification.

4.2 BIDDERS ACKNOWLEDMENT

The Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 120 days after the Bid Opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner

4.3 DUPLICATE BID

No more than one (1) bid from any Bidder will be considered by the County. In the event multiple bids are submitted in violation of this provision, the County will have the right to determine which bid will be considered, or at its sole option, reject all such multiple bids.

4.4 BID SIGNATURES

An authorized company official must sign Bids. Each signature represents binding commitment upon the Bidder to provide the goods and/or services offered to the County if the Bidder is determined to be the lowest responsive, responsible Bidder.

4.5 BIDDERS RESPONSIBILITIES

The Bidder must be capable, either as a firm or a team, of providing all parts as described herein. Exclusion of any parts or services for this Bid may serve as cause for rejection.

The successful Bidder will be responsible for all work in this solicitation whether it is provided or performed by the successful Bidder or subcontractor(s). Further, the County will consider the successful Bidder to be the sole point of contact with regard to contractual matters, including payment of any and all charges resulting from the cost of any contract. The successful Bidder must be an authorized dealer of the proposed scale and associated

equipment. This manufacturer authorization must include required installation certifications and warranty work provisions.

5 SCOPE OF WORK

Although Union County is one of the fastest growing counties in North Carolina, it still retains open stretches of farmland where agricultural roots run deep. To this end, the County has defined a "Farm Theme" for the Jesse Helms Park Playground. The area is approximately 40,000 square feet.

The County envisions 4 play areas with farm related features:

- 1. Tractor, Barn, & Cornstalk play area for ages 2 5
- 2. Barn Play Area for ages 5 12
- 3. Swing Area
- 4. Flower Inclusive Play Area

This bid is for the purchase, delivery, and installation of inclusive playground equipment designed for children 2 years to 12 years of age as described in this solicitation and as listed on Appendix A - Specification Form.

The items selected were specified to achieve design aesthetics and quality desired for specific needs appropriate for this project. Although the manufacturer for the selected list is **GameTime**, it is not the intent to discriminate against an "or equal" product. It is the intent to set a definite standard. Open competition is expected and desired but, in all cases, complete supporting data must be submitted on or before, May 15, 2024, on <u>all substitutions and exceptions proposed</u>. Samples and/or documentation shall be submitted for comparison. Bidders are requested to offer only equivalent comparable units, which will provide the theme, features and performance needed and implied.

All Products and component parts furnished under the Contract shall be new, shall comply with the specifications and terms and conditions set forth in this IFB, and shall operate in full compliance with these Specifications.

<u>Note</u>: Because of the differences between manufacturers in the design, materials and construction methods, the County reserves the right to evaluate all bids and to vary from these specifications when in its opinion, such variances is in the County's best interest. This includes the approval of substitutions by the bidder for one item for another as being equal to specifications, performance and quality. The specifications and requirements described are to indicate certain features requested by the County and are in no way to be construed to be restrictive to eliminate any item or items which are necessary to provide a complete, safe and fully functional system.

5.1 KEY FEATURES

Playground equipment should include:

- A variety of play structures including swings, slides, balance elements, Americans with disabilities Act (ADA) elements and rope elements.
- Creative designs to stimulate children's imagination during play.
- Safety features such as soft-landing surfaces to adhere to Certified Playground Safety Inspector (CPSI) fall standards.

- Interactive panels and/or signage to promote curiosity.
- Opportunities for educational learning through play and cognitive development.
- ADA accessibility standards.
- A routine maintenance plan to ensure the longevity of the area.
- Evidenced-based design best practices to promote youth physical activity and provide a validated overview of the levels of challenge to include beginning, intermediate, and advanced skills levels.
- Evidenced-based design best practices using the <u>7 Principles of Inclusive</u>
 <u>Playground Design</u> and demonstrate how the design addresses a robust balance
 of activities that addresses the developmental needs of the whole child.
- Evidence that demonstrates the impact on community health and wellness through data services and site-specific reports.
- Tools, resources, and support to help promote the site, create awareness, and demonstrate leadership.
- Educational training (virtual, in-person, or on-site) for staff about the features/benefits of the design and how to program the space.
- International Play Equipment Manufacturers Association (IPEMA) certified protective safety surfacing.

6 SPECIFICATIONS

All Products and component parts furnished shall be new, shall comply with the specifications and terms and conditions set forth in this IFB, and shall operate in full compliance with these Specifications. Pricing indicates a full Turnkey project, including but not limited to management, equipment, installation, testing, and training.

- All work to be performed during normal business hours: 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday Friday. Work on County's holidays is not permitted.
- Provide full project management and project scheduling with updates.
- Provide all permits, insurance, and licenses.
- Comply with ADA standards.

6.1 SPECIFICATIONS FORM

Please check <u>Comply</u> or <u>Does Not Comply</u> for each item listed on **Appendix A** - **Specification Form**. Items checked <u>Comply</u>, must meet specifications exactly. For all the items checked <u>Does Not Comply</u>, clearly note differences in the space provided or on a separate sheet of paper. Provide product technical data/specification documents (cut sheets) and other documentation as needed to comply with the Scope of Work and Specifications outlined in this solicitation. Please do not include any sales or marketing brochures.

All substitutions and exceptions proposed must be emailed to vicky.watts@unioncountync.gov no later than 5:00 PM Local Time on May 15, 2024. After review by County staff, the decision to accept or reject the proposed exception or "Like Model" will be issued by Addendum.

The County reserves the right to review any exceptions and determine acceptability. Failure to note exceptions will result in rejection of bid.

6.2 LICENSURE

Play structures shall meet all provisions of both the CPSC (most current edition) "Handbook for Public Playground Safety" and ASTM F1487-21 "Standard Consumer Safety Performance Specification for Playground Equipment for Public Use" and be purchased from IPEMA certified manufacturers.

6.3 WARRANTY

The Contractor warrants that all Equipment shall be new and of good quality and shall provide a limited lifetime warranty on uprights, hardware, and connections. A detailed warranty must be submitted with bid. The express warranty contained in this section shall not diminish any of Union County's rights against Contractor with respect to the time within which proceedings may be commenced to establish Contractor's liability with respect to Contractor's obligations other than specifically to correct Work.

6.5 SUBCONTRACTOR

If subcontractors are to be used on this project, please submit with bid the following information:

A contractor whose Bid is accepted shall not substitute any person as subcontractor in the place of the subcontractor listed in the original bid, except (a) if the listed subcontractor's bid is later determined by the contractor to be non-responsible or nonresponsive or the listed subcontractor refuses to enter into a contract for the complete performance of the bid work, or (b) with the approval of the awarding authority for good cause shown by the contractor.

The terms, conditions, and requirements of each contract between Contractor and a subcontractor performing work under a subdivision or branch of work listed in this subsection shall incorporate by reference the terms, conditions, and requirements of the Contract between Contractor and Owner. Failure to include this list of subcontractors may cause a Bid to be rejected as nonresponsive by Owner.

If Owner, after due investigation, has reasonable objection to any proposed Subcontractor, Supplier, individual, or entity, Owner may, before the Notice of Award is given, request apparent Successful Bidder to submit a substitute, without an increase in the Bid.

Subsequent to the submittal of the Bid, Owner may not require the Successful Bidder or Contractor to retain any Subcontractor, Supplier, or other individual or entity against which Contractor has reasonable objection.

6.6 MANUFACTURERS' NAMES

Any manufacturers' names, trade names, brand names, information and/or catalog numbers used herein are for purpose of description and establishing general quality levels. Such references are not intended to be restrictive and equivalent products of any manufacturer may be offered. Determination of equivalency shall rest solely with the County.

6.7 DEVIATIONS

Any deviations from specifications and requirements herein must be clearly pointed out by bidder. Otherwise it will be considered that products offered will be in strict compliance with these specifications and requirements, and successful bidder will be held responsible therefor. Deviations must be explained in detail on an attached sheet. However, no implication is made by Union County that deviations will be acceptable. Bidder is advised that the response (or lack thereof) on this question does not take precedence over specific responses or non-responses provided elsewhere in this bid.

6.8 SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Contractor shall:

- 1. Protect existing amenities of the site during the project and shall be held liable for any resulting damages.
- 2. Be responsible for installation of all new materials.
- 3. Be responsible for all cleanup of area following completion of project.
- 4. Provide anticipated delivery dates for all items within 3 weeks of bid award.
- 5. Must notify the County if the anticipated delivery date changes.
- 6. Provide regular updates in writing of status changes and or anticipated delivery dates
- 7. Attend requested meetings as required for general site coordination.
- 8. Inspect playground equipment for damages and or defects.
- 9. Assume responsibility for any damages, errors, or omissions attributable to the shipper, manufacturer, or installation and reorder products for like in new condition.
- 10. Coordinate all warranty services and provide copies of warranties & maintenance information.

6.9 DELIVERY AND CHARGES

No additional freight shall be charged at time of delivery. Risk of loss and/or damage shall be upon the seller until such time as goods have been physically delivered and received by the County.

7 EVALUATION OF BIDS AND AWARD PROCEDURES

7.1 BID INFORMATION

Bids must be made in strict conformance using the Invitation for Bid (IFB) forms provided herein. All blank spaces for bids must be filled in properly. Numbers must be written in ink or typewritten, and the completed forms shall be without erasures, lineation, or alterations. In accepting the bid, the County will assume that no alterations have been made, and if they appear afterward, they shall not be binding on the County.

All Bid Documents shall be signed by an individual who is authorized to contractually bind the company. The signature must indicate the title or position the individual holds in the agency or firm. Agencies or firms which sign contracts with the name of the agency or firm must provide the name of a corporate officer or executive director for signature validation by the County. All unsigned Bids will be disqualified. In submitting a Bid, Offeror affirms all statements contained in the bid are true and accurate.

7.2 TERMS OF SUBMISSION

All material received from a person or company ("Respondent") in response to this solicitation shall become the property of Union County and will not be returned to the Respondent. Any and all costs incurred by a Respondent in preparing, submitting, or presenting submissions are the Respondent's sole responsibility and Union County shall not reimburse the Respondent. All responses to this solicitation will be considered a public record and subject to disclosure under applicable public records law.

Any material in a response which the Respondent considers a trade secret and exempt from disclosure as a public record under applicable law, including N.C.G.S. §§ 132-1.2 and 66-152, must be properly designated as a trade secret. In order to properly designate such material, the Respondent must: (i) submit any trade secret materials in a separate envelope, or file, from all other submitted material, being clearly marked as "Trade Secret – Confidential and Proprietary Information," and (ii) stamp the same trade secret/confidentiality designation on each page of the materials therein which contain trade secrets.

To the extent consistent with public records law, Union County will make reasonable efforts to maintain the confidential nature of trade secrets, as determined by Union County and subject to the conditions set forth herein. Respondent understands and agrees by submitting a response to this solicitation, that if a request is made to review or produce a copy of any information in the Respondent's materials which was properly labeled by the Respondent as a trade secret, Union County will notify the Respondent of the request and the date that such materials will be released to the requestor unless the Respondent

obtains a court order enjoining that disclosure. If the Respondent fails to obtain the court order enjoining disclosure prior to that date, Respondent understands and agrees that Union County will release the requested information to the requestor on that date.

Furthermore, the Respondent also agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Union County and each of its officers, employees, and agents from all costs, damages, and expenses incurred in connection with refusing to disclose any material that has been designated as a trade secret by Respondent.

7.3 AWARD

The award shall be made to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, taking into consideration quality, performance, and the time specified in the bid for the performance of the contract

A Bid may be rejected if it is incomplete. Union County may reject any or all Bids and may waive any immaterial deviation in a Bid.

More than one Bid from an individual, firm, partnership, corporation or association under the same or different names, will not be considered. In the event multiple bids are submitted in violation of this provision, the County will have the right to determine which bid will be considered, or at its sole option, reject all such multiple bids.

The award document may incorporate, by reference, all the requirements, terms and conditions of the solicitation and the Bidder's Bid as negotiated.

The County shall have a period of 120 days after opening of Bids in which to award the contract. A Contract shall serve as the agreement for the purpose of this award. Contents of the Bid shall become contractual obligations if a contract ensues. Failure of the Bidder to honor these obligations may result in cancellation of the award.

7.4 APPLICATION OF NORTH CAROLINA GENERAL STATUTES

The General Statutes of North Carolina regarding purchasing and competitive bidding (G.S. § 143-129) are made a part herein and will govern the bidding process as applicable.

8 GENERAL CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

8.1 MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDERS

The Bidder must be capable, either as a firm or a team, of providing all parts as described herein. Exclusion of any parts or services for this Bid may serve as cause for rejection.

The successful Bidder will be responsible for all work in this solicitation whether provided or performed by the successful Bidder or subcontractor(s). Further, the County will consider the successful Bidder to be the sole point of contact with regard to contractual matters, including payment of any and all charges resulting from the cost of any contract.

Bids shall be considered only from companies normally engaged in providing the type of equipment specified in this solicitation. Union County, in its discretion, shall determine whether the evidence of responsibility and ability to perform is satisfactory.

The Bidder should have previous experience in the performance of projects of a similar nature to ensure timely and efficient completion of this project.

The individual/firm warrants that he/she is fully qualified, with adequate personnel and experience, to undertake the services required. The Offeror shall also certify that insurance coverage that meets or exceeds industry standards for this type of work will be in force to mitigate risk during performance under the contract.

8.2 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All payroll taxes, liability and worker's compensation are the sole responsibility of the Offeror. The Offeror understands that an employer/employee relationship does not exist under this contract.

The County reserves the right to reject any and all bids, the right to waive informalities, and the right to disregard nonconforming or conditional bids or counter bids. It is the intention of Union County to execute a final, binding Contract with the successful Offeror which incorporates terms and conditions no less onerous than those appropriate to the engagement of a licensed contracting firm in connection with a project of this magnitude.

All bids submitted in response to this request shall become the property of Union County and as such, may be subject to public review.

8.3 IFB EXPENSES

Expenses for developing the bids are entirely the responsibility of the Contractor and shall not be chargeable in any way to the County.

8.4 CERTIFICATION

In response to the IFB Request, the Contractor certifies the following:

- This bid is signed by an authorized representative of the firm;
- It can obtain insurance certificates as required within ten (10) calendar days after notice of award;
- All labor costs, direct and indirect, have been determined and included in the proposed cost; and
- The potential Contractor has read and understands the conditions set forth in this solicitation.

8.5 FINANCIAL INFORMATION

The Bidder must have the following financial information readily available and have the ability to provide it to the County, without exception, within twenty-four (24) hours upon request during the bid certification process:

- 1. Annual audited financial reports for the past five (5) fiscal years;
- 2. Credit reports, credit bulletins, bank and contractor references, and any other
- 3. published statements by agencies that have been issued or published about the entity within the past five (5) years;
- 4. Indicate whether the Company (and/or predecessor, guarantor, or subcontractor) has declared bankruptcy within the last five (5) years;

5. Provide a description of the financial impact of any past or pending legal proceedings and judgments that could materially affect the Bidder's financial position or ability to provide service to the County.

8.6 CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATIONS

The contents of this Bid and the commitments set forth in the Bid shall be considered contractual obligations if a contract ensues. Failure to accept these obligations may result in cancellation of the award. All legally required terms and conditions shall be incorporated into final contract agreements with the selected Service

8.7 COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

Seller represents and warrants that the performance of this order and the furnishing of goods or services required shall be in accordance with the applicable standards, provisions and stipulations of all pertinent Federal, State or County laws, rules, regulations, resolutions and ordinances including but not limited to the Fair Labor Standards Act, the Equal Employment Opportunity rules and regulations and the Occupational Safety and Health Acts.

8.8 SUBCONTRACTOR DISCLOSURE

A single Company may propose the entire solution. If the Bid by any Company requires the use of sub-contractors, partners, and/or third-party products or services, this must be clearly stated in the Bid. The Company submitting the Bid shall remain solely responsible for the performance of all work, including work that is done by sub-contractors.

A contractor whose Bid is accepted shall not substitute any person as subcontractor in the place of the subcontractor listed in the original bid, except (a) if the listed subcontractor's bid is later determined by the contractor to be non-responsible or nonresponsive or the listed subcontractor refuses to enter into a contract for the complete performance of the bid work, or (b) with the approval of the awarding authority for good cause shown by the contractor. The terms, conditions, and requirements of each contract between Contractor and a subcontractor performing work under a subdivision or branch of work listed in this subsection shall incorporate by reference the terms, conditions, and requirements of the Contract between Contractor and Owner. Failure to include this list of subcontractors may cause a Bid to be rejected as nonresponsive by Owner.


