Sealed bids for construction of Jesse Helms Park Playground Equipment will be received by the Union County Procurement Department *until 2:00 PM* local time on **July 19, 2024** at the Union County Government Center, 500 North Main Street, Suite 709, Monroe, NC 28112 at which time the bids will be opened and read aloud. **Late bids will not be accepted.**

If a Bid is sent by mail or other delivery system, the sealed envelope containing the Bid shall be enclosed in a separate package plainly marked on the outside with the notation “**BID ENCLOSED, 2024-071Rebid**” and shall be addressed to Union County Procurement Department, Attn: Vicky Watts, 500 North Main Street, Suite 709, Monroe, NC 28112.

Union County, North Carolina, through Parks and Recreation, is soliciting bids from qualified firms to furnish, deliver and install playground equipment to Jesse Helms Park as outlined in this solicitation.

This solicitation may be examined at the Union County Government Center, Procurement and Contract Management Department, 500 North Main Street, Suite 709, Monroe, NC 28112, Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 am and 5:00 pm. A Non-Mandatory, Pre-Bid Conference & Site Visit was held on **May 9, 2024 at 10:00 AM Local Time** at the Jesse Helms Park Playground, 1505 Summerlin Dairy Road, Wingate, NC 28174. Representatives from Union County Parks and Recreation will be on-hand to give a brief overview of the project and to answer questions. Attendance at this meeting is strongly encouraged.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum basis as indicated in the Bid Form.

All questions about the meaning or intent of the Bidding Documents are to be submitted in writing to the Procurement contact person listed on the cover page (vicky.watts@unioncountync.gov). Deadline for questions was **June 17, 2024 at 3:00 PM** local time.

Bidders must have a license to do work as a general contractor in the State of North Carolina, as set forth under Article 1 chapter 87 of the North Carolina General statutes. The bidder's North Carolina Contractor license number shall be designated on the outside of the sealed envelope containing the Bid.

Bidders are required to comply with the non-collusion requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents.

As provided by statute, a deposit of cash, cashier's check or certified check on some bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit insurance Company, or a bid bond executed by corporate surety licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute such bonds in the amount of 5% of the bid must accompany each bid. The payee shall be "**Union County**". Said deposit shall guarantee that the Agreement will be entered into by the successful bidder if award is made. Such deposit may be held by Union County until the successful bidder has executed and delivered all required Contract documents to Union County.

The County reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids, including, without limitation, nonconforming, nonresponsive, unbalanced, or conditional bids. The County also reserves the right to waive informalities and request clarification as needed.

Good Faith effort outreach to Minority Businesses (HUB Certified) and Small Businesses shall be documented in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Bidders should note the provisions of the Instructions to Bidders contained in the Bid Documents regarding HUB/minority participation. Bidders shall submit a completed identification of HUB Certified/Minority Participation form and either Affidavit A or Affidavit B as applicable, with their bid.

Union County intends to pay, in part or in whole, the cost of the contract resulting from this solicitation using federal funds received from the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, Public Law 93-383, as amended 42 U.S.C. 5301 et seq., Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) This solicitation follows the Uniform Administrative Requirements (UG), Cost Principals, and Audit Requirements for Federal awards (2 C.F.R. Part 200). Contracts resulting from this solicitation may be funded with federal grant funds which have been procured in a manner that is in compliance with all applicable Federal laws, policies, and standards as well as state law and local policies.
