

## Standing Pull-up Changing Procedure

This policy applies to all children that are in the process of being toilet trained. The children must be wearing pull-ups or cloth underwear. If a child is wearing a diaper, the diaper must be changed at an approved diaper changing station.

- 1. Gather supplies.
- Take the child to the restroom.
- 3. Put on gloves (required for employees with chapped skin, cuts, or sores on hands.)
- 4. Remove any soiled clothing and place in a plastic bag. Always store soiled clothing out of reach of children.
- 5. Remove pull-up by pulling the sides apart & discard in a plastic-lined, covered trashcan.
- 6. Clean the child from front to back using clean wipes.
- 7. Discard soiled wipes and gloves in plasitc-lined, covered trashcan.
- 8. Wipe your hands.
- 9. Allow the child to use the toilet if needed.
- 10. While in restroom, assist child as needed in putting on a clean pullup/underwear and getting re-dressed.
- 11. Supervise child in washing their hands in accordance with approved handwashing procedures.
- 12. Return the child to the classroom without touching other surfaces.
- 13. Clean the toilet used and any other soiled surfaces with soapy water solution and then spray the surfaces with an approved disinfectant.
- 14. Allow the disinfectant to air dry for 2 minutes and then wipe the surface dry. (If using EPA registered disinfectant, follow manufacturer's instructions for required contact times.)
- 15. Wash your hands according to approved handwashing procedures.
